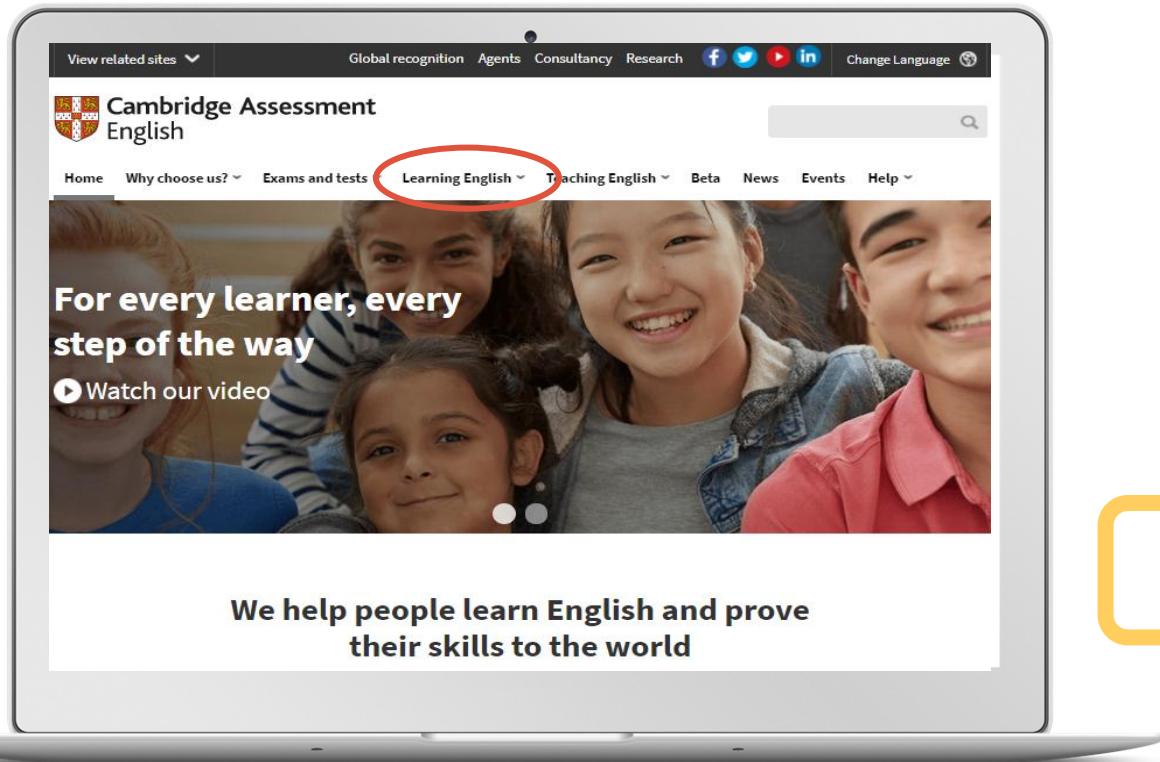


The SAMR ladder (Ruben Puentedura, 2006)
